

MFA Setup


- 1. Navigate to https://aka.ms/mfasetup (you may need to log in with your email and Microsoft Password)
- 2. Click "Next"

4. Click "Next"




- 5. Switch to your mobile device / cell phone that you want to use for MFA

7. Search for "Microsoft authenticator"




8. Download the app, the icon looks like this:






9. Open the newly-downloaded app




10. Allow any permissions that it asks for




11. Click "I Agree"



12. Click "Scan a QR code", the 3rd option




- 13. If it asks for any permissions to the camera, accept them. It should show you your camera.
- 14. Point your camera at the QR code on the computer screen:




15. When your phone shows the account, click "Next" on the computer
